As per usual, although golfing activity has been slow lately, things have been hopping around the clubhouse.

Our new Yamaha gas-powered golf carts with

USB charging ports should start to arrive the week of January 9—it will take a few days to get them all in. We anticipate that they should be available for use by the middle of the month, barring any weather-related delays. Yamaha will take the old carts once the new ones are delivered.

Changes in the Tern Grille are scheduled to start on January 10. The planned changes include an expanded bar, enclosing the screened-in area, widening the dining area, new flooring and a hallway for access

to the bathrooms without having to go through the golf shop. A picture of the plans is below. Please note that the picture is not to scale. Ocean Pines Public Works and other contractors will be completing the work. The renovation is expected to be completed by March 1, just in time for the beginning of the golf season.

Upgrades to the downstairs bathrooms include new tile and fixtures.

The project to replace the roof, which began in December, should be complet-

ed by January 15.

Finally, plans to renovate the upstairs of the clubhouse are being finalized by the OPA Board this month. Work on this renovation is slated to begin on May 1. I will share those plans with you once they are finalized.
